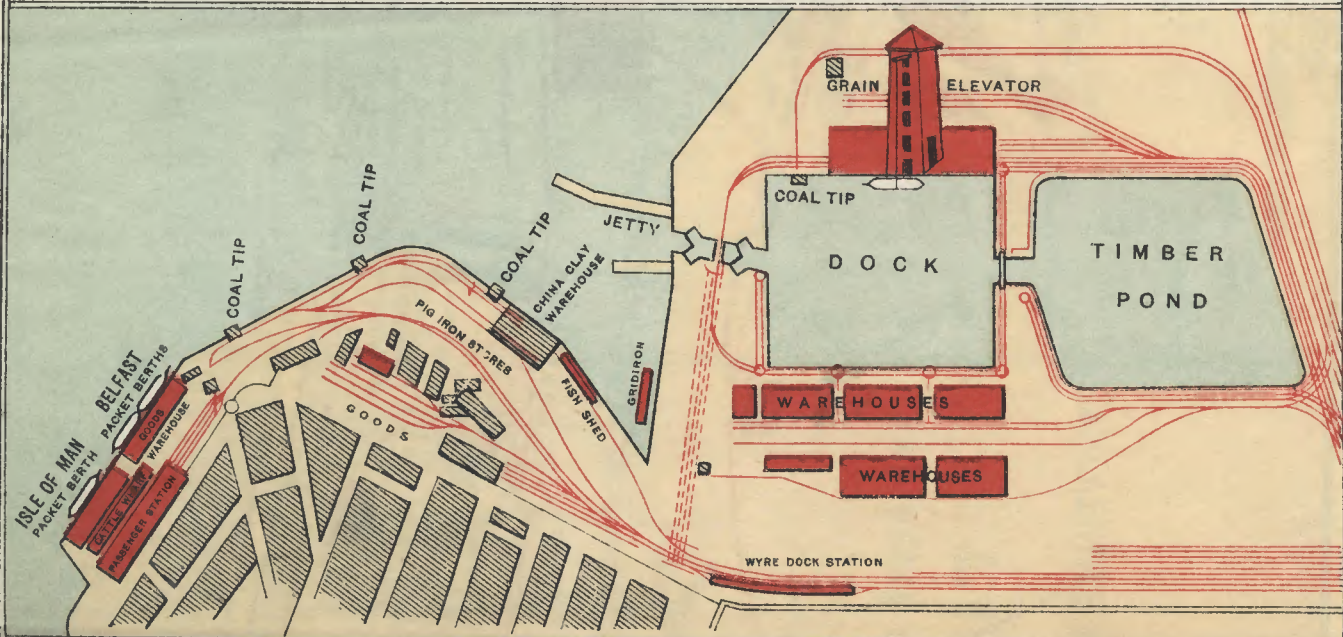

PLAN SHEWING LANCASHIRE AND YORKSHIRE RAILWAY DOCKS, QUAYS, AND WAREHOUSES AT FLEETWOOD.

The Total Dock Area is 25 Acres, and the Shed Area 5267 Square Yards. Railway Wagons run alongside the Dock Quays and River Wharves, and Merchandise is transhipped direct, without risk or expense of Cartage. The New Grain Elevator, on the American principle, is capable of lifting and storing Grain from Ships at the rate of One Hundred and Twenty Tons per Hour, thus ensuring exceptionally quick despatch to Vessels. There are Eight Steam Cranes and Three Coal Tips on the Docks and Quays.

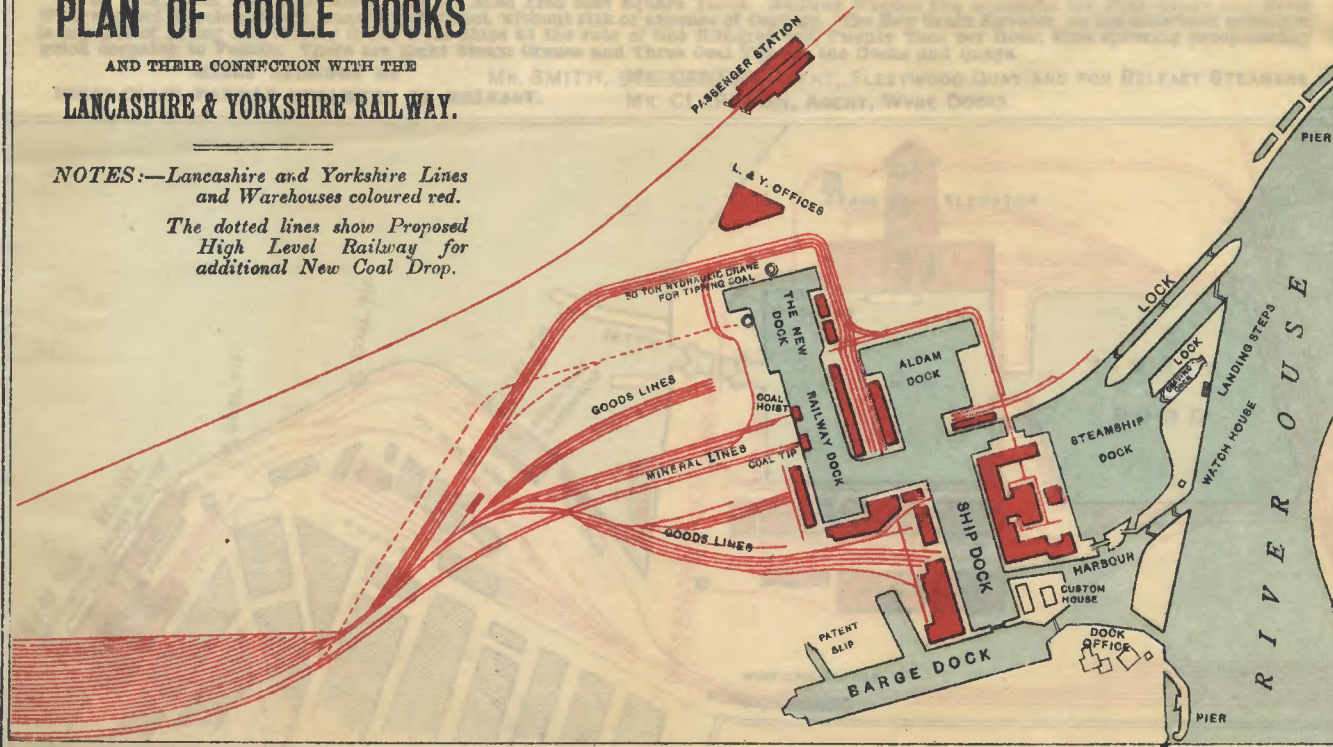


PLAN OF COOLE DOCKS

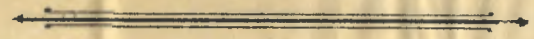

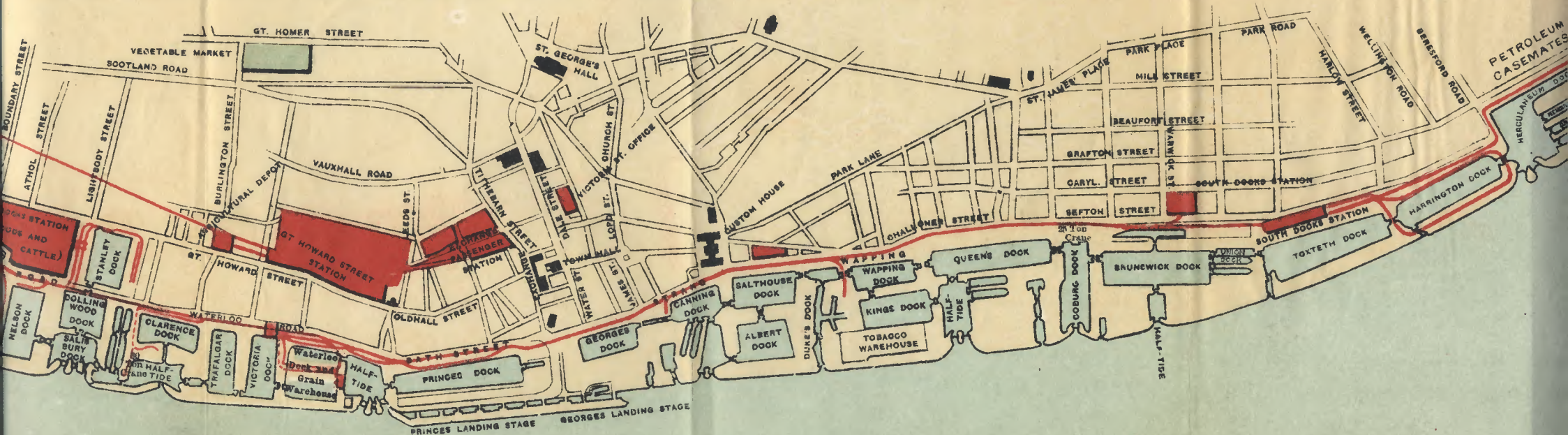

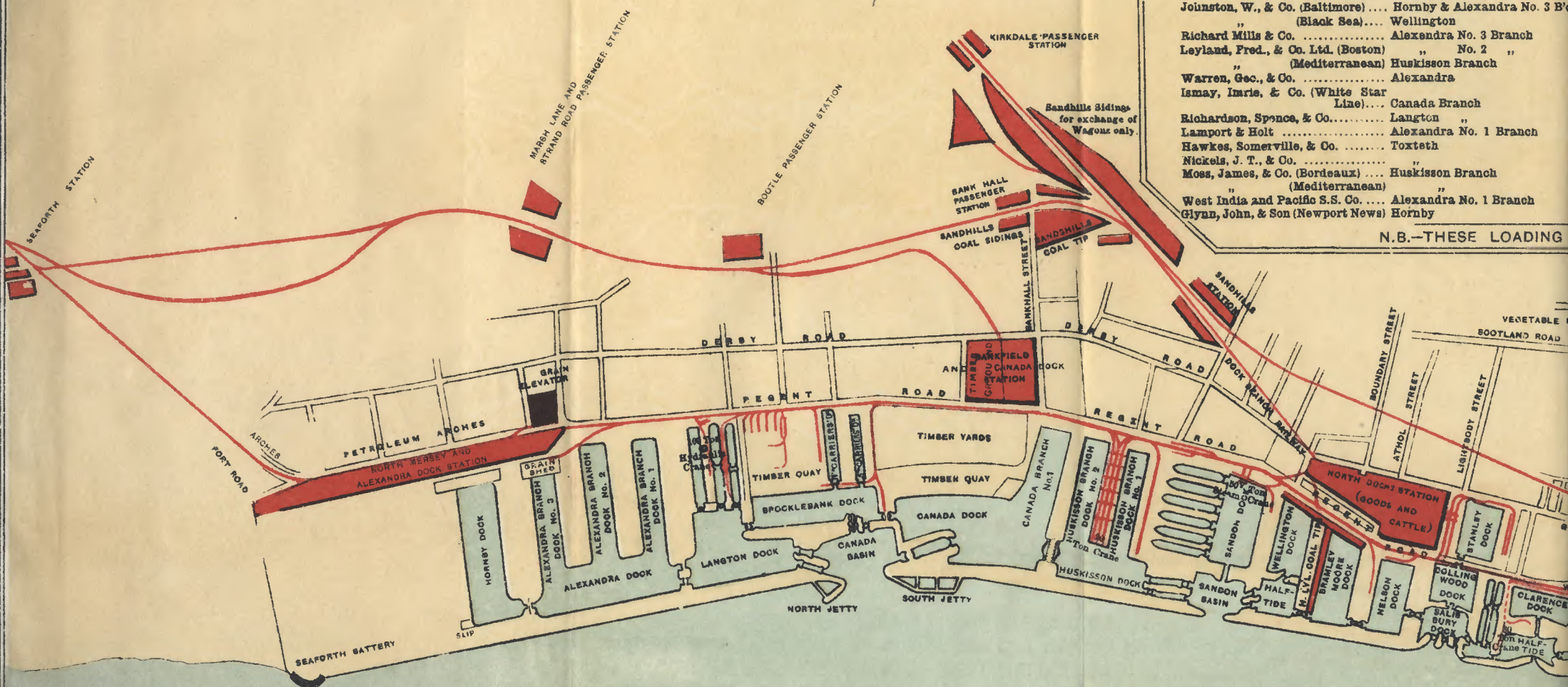
