- Fleetwood to Preston.

No. 2 TOUR.

- Preston to Fleetwood.
- Fleetwood to Blackpool.
- Blackpool to Preston.


FARES—Third Class, Half-day, 1/9; Day, 2/0.

Passengers must travel from Preston to Blackpool or Fleetwood and back by the Trains advertised above for Day and Half-day Excursions in both directions, but the journey between Blackpool and Fleetwood may be performed by ANY Ordinary Train.

CHRISTMAS AND NEW YEAR HOLIDAYS.

Short-date Tickets, advertised in the Week-end Programmes, issued on Fridays, December 23rd and 30th, and Saturdays, December 24th and 31st will be available for return on the following Sunday (where Train service permits), Monday, Tuesday, or Wednesday by ANY Ordinary Train except where stated to the contrary.

Holders of Day and Half-day Tickets return the same day from Manchester (Victoria Station, No. 12 Platform), by ANY Train after 5-0 p.m.; holders of 4 Days Tickets return on the following Sunday, Monday, or Tuesday by ANY Train.

The issuing of Through Tickets is subject to the conditions and regulations referred to in the Time Tables, Bills, and Notices of the respective Companies on whose Railways, Coaches, or Steamboats they are available, and the holder, by accepting a Through Ticket, agrees that the respective Companies are not to be liable for any loss or damage, injury, delay, or detention caused or arising off their respective Railways, Coaches, or Steamboats. The contract and liability of each Company are limited to its own Railway, Coaches, or Steamboats.

AVAILABILITY OF EXCURSION TICKETS.

The RETURN Halves of Short and Long Date Excursion Tickets issued by ordinary trains (a) between any two stations on the L. & Y. Line, (b) between any two stations on the L. & N. W. Line, or (c) between any station on the L. & Y. Line and any station on the L. & N. W. Line are available by the trains of either Company, where such trains enable the Holder to travel the whole or a part of the journey, between the point of booking and destination, by the direct route; but the OUTWARD Halves of such tickets are available only by the trains of the Company for which they are issued.

Tickets between the undermentioned points are excepted from the foregoing arrangements, viz. :—

Southport Line Stations and Liverpool
Manchester and Oldham
Manchester and Huddersfield

All Yorkshire Stations and Ashton Branch
Stations, including Stalybridge
All Yorkshire Stations and Oldham

The OUTWARD and RETURN Halves of Day and Half-day Excursion Tickets, and Pleasure Party, Market, and Workmen's Tickets, are not available except by the Trains of the Company for which they are issued.

Excursion Tickets are not transferable, and are available only to and from the Stations named upon them and by the Trains advertised in the Company's Bills, &c., announcing the Excursion, and if used to or from a Station beyond or short of the Stations named on the Tickets, or by Trains not advertised in the Bills, &c., they will be forfeited, and the Holders thereof will be charged the full Ordinary Fare for the whole distance travelled.

Day and Half-day Excursion Tickets cannot be extended, nor can any allowance be made on return portions not used.

TICKETS USED IN A SUPERIOR CLASS OF CARRIAGE.

Passengers travelling with Week-end and Excursion Tickets in a superior class of carriage to that which by their tickets they are entitled will be charged the difference between the fare paid and the advertised fare for the superior class of carriage used. If no higher class fare advertised, then the difference between the fare paid and the return fare (Ordinary or Tourist as the case may be) for the superior class of carriage used. If the passengers travel in a superior class one way only, half the respective differences will be charged.

No Luggage allowed to Day and Half-day Trip Passengers, but Passengers holding Extension Tickets will be allowed 60lbs. of Luggage Free, under their own care, for which the Railway Company will not be responsible.

TICKETS, Bills, and all particulars may be obtained in advance at the Stations; and at Messrs. COOK & SON'S 83, Fishergate, PRESTON.
