Loading of Goods Traffic from Stations on the North Eastern Railway to Stations on and beyond the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway.

For the purpose of the following instructions the Lancashire and Yorkshire Railway has been divided into five divisions, in each of which there is a Main Tranship Station. The divisions are in some cases divided into zones, in each of which there is a Sub-Tranship Station.

The stations served by the respective Main and Sub-Tranship Stations are shewn on the attached list, and the following is a summary of the alternative methods of loading which must be adopted in all cases in the order in which they are given below :—

1. Load 2 tons or more in one wagon to destination.
2. Load 2 tons or more in one wagon to any Sub-Tranship station for stations within its zone.
3. (a) Load 2 tons or more in one wagon to a Main Tranship station for all stations in the Division served by such Main station.
(b) Load 2 tons or more in one wagon to the Main Tranship station shewn below for all stations in the combination of Divisions named :—

<u>For stations in</u>	<u>Load wagon to</u>
Blackburn and Salford & Bolton Divisions	Bolton
Blackburn, Salford & Bolton, Oldham Road and Thornhill Divisions	Thornhill.

- 4 Load to a North Eastern Sub-Tranship station either your own or in the direction of destination in conformity with the N.E. loading instructions.

The following is a list of the cases where a wagon may be sent forward with less than 2 tons :—

- (a) If the consignment is of such a bulky nature that less than this weight fills the wagon.
- (b) Where the minimum weight of 2 tons is paid for.
- (c) If the traffic is perishable, or consists of market produce. In this case the present minimum for a through wagon may be adhered to.
- (d) If special permission is given for through wagons to be used (*e.g.*) for urgent shipment traffic, skin, or other traffic which is unsuitable for loading with general traffic.
- (e) L. & Y. wagons may be loaded home with traffic irrespective of weight, but when the loads consist of less than 20 cwts., the wagons should be ticketed to Thornhill or Leeds according to the routing of the traffic. L. & Y. wagons containing traffic for Liverpool and Fleetwood, must be labelled through to destination irrespective of weight.

NOTE.—It is not intended that these instructions shall interfere in any way with the operation of the existing route list.
